

**CIS SUGAR MARKET NEWS**
**UKRAINE**


According to the State Fiscal Service, imports of sugar and raw sugar (HS code 1701) made in the amount of US\$ 18804 million in the first three months (January-March) of 2016; in March only – US\$ 171 thousand. Imports fall associated with the delivery of large quantities of raw sugar to Ukraine in January-February 2016. Sugar exports in March also made an insignificant amount, as the main quota for duty free exports to the EU in 2016 have exhausted within the first two months.
